

## INSPECTOR PRIORITY ZONES

**Effective MARCH 13, 2017**

As of March 13, 2017, the State will be divided into three (3) priority inspection zones. This means there will be one inspector who is the priority inspector for a zoned area. However, should any Authority inspector have a lighter or heavier workload in their priority zone, another Authority inspector will cross over and conduct inspections in a zone that is not their priority zone area. Rotation will be done periodically to keep each inspector acquainted with construction processes/procedures/codes in all areas of the State as well as work with all Participants in the various development programs.
