Palmetto State Housing Study

About the Study

The SC Legislature passed a budget proviso in June 2022 requiring the University of South Carolina (USC) Darla Moore School of Business, in partnership with the South Carolina State Housing Finance and Development Authority (SC Housing), to conduct a statewide housing needs assessment by June 30, 2023. The "Palmetto State Housing Study" was launched to fulfill this requirement.

The study will examine a broad range of housing issues facing the state, such as housing production and availability, neighborhood conservation, housing for persons with special needs, fair housing and accessibility, housing cost burden, eviction rates, homelessness and housing affordability. It will also explore each region's unique housing challenges and include demographic analyses and forecasts of future housing needs and supply.
